RESOLUTION NO. 14-1994

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF TRAFFIC LIGHT SYNCHRONIZATION PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene recognizes that it is in the interest of the national economy to promote the conservation of energy resources and to reduce our nation's dependence on costly foreign oil; and,

WHEREAS, the retiming of signals by the City of Abilene will provide benefits to the local community in the form of improved traffic flow, reduced fuel consumption, reduced vehicle operating costs, reduced air pollutant emissions, and improved safety due to smoother traffic flow; and,

WHEREAS, funds have been established and are available through the Texas Department of Transportation for grants to local governments for traffic signal retiming projects; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: Authorizes the submission of applications to the Texas Department of Transportation for a Traffic Light Synchronization grant; and,

PART 2: If these applications are selected for funding, the City Manager of the City of Abilene is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Abilene all necessary applications, contracts, and agreements to implement and carry out the purposes specified in this resolution.
