

RESOLUTION NO. 29-1994

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING "NO MONEY, NO MANDATES" AND DISCHARGE PETITION NUMBER 25.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, strongly supports the concept of "no money, no mandates"; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, urges that the Congress pass discharge petition number 25 and take action to support "no money, no mandates; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, hereby supports the adoption of legislation providing for "no money, no mandates".


PART 2: That the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, hereby urges that discharge petition number 25 be approved so as to bring forth legislation supporting "no money, no mandates".



PART 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.


