

RESOLUTION NO. 1-1995

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS TO THE ABILENE DISTRICT OFFICE OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FUNDING IN THE 1996-1998 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) brought about changes in the process of selecting projects for Federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Abilene District Office of the Texas Department of Transportation has requested that local governments submit candidate projects for State or Federal funding in the 1996-1998 Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene maintains an annually updated list of capital needs projects through its Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has determined that the projects listed in Exhibit A meet the requirements for Federal funding and are of the highest priority; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit to the Abilene District Office of the Texas Department of Transportation the projects in Exhibit A as the City's priority list of projects for consideration for funding in the 1996-1998 Transportation Improvement Program.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit supporting documentation for these projects as requested by the Texas Department of Transportation.

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
