**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE
COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION,
SERIES 1995**

The City of Abilene does hereby give notice of intention to issue Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 1995, in the maximum principal amount not to exceed \$2,100,000 for paying all or a portion of the City's contractual obligations for the purpose of providing \$1,090,000 for constructing, improving and repairing the City's streets, drainage improvements, and traffic improvements; \$680,000 for Public Safety improvements (Fire Department equipment); and \$330,000 for Park System repairs and improvements, and for paying legal, fiscal and engineering fees in connection with such projects. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such Certificates of Obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law, and from the surplus revenues of the City's Waterworks and Sewer System, remaining after payment of all operation and maintenance expenses thereof, and all debt service, reserve, and other requirements in connection with all of the City's revenue bonds or other obligations (now or hereafter outstanding), which are payable from all or any part of the Net Revenues of the City's Waterworks and Sewer System, not to exceed \$2,500. The City Council intends to consider for passage at a Regular Meeting to be held at 11:00 A.M., C.D.T., on April 27, 1995, an Ordinance authorizing the issuance of City of Abilene, Texas Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 1995, at the City Hall, Abilene, Texas.
