

RESOLUTION NO. 20-1995

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE SUSPENSION OF WEST TEXAS UTILITIES PROPOSED RATE INCREASE.

WHEREAS, West Texas Utilities has filed an application for a system-wide increase to become effective April 4, 1995; and,

WHEREAS, West Texas Utilities has agreed to move its effective date to April 18, 1995, and now to June 4, 1995; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens for the Council to extend the ninety (90) day suspension period from the new effective date until September 2, 1995, in order that the proposed increase can be studied and evaluated; and,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the proposed West Texas Utilities rate increase is hereby suspended for a period of ninety (90) days from the projected new effective date of June 4, 1995, to September 2, 1995, in order that the City may have time to adequately review such proposed rate increase.

PART 2: That should any new effective date be established by West Texas Utilities, the proposed rate increase is hereby suspended for a period of ninety (90) days from the new effective date.


PART 3: That the charges for electricity and electric service within the city while the rates are suspended shall be those interim rates approved by Ordinance No. 43-1994.

PART 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
