A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE *MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR AERONAUTICAL ACTIVITIES* AT THE ABILENE REGIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the City Council by Oral Resolution during the March 10, 1988, Council Meeting adopted the *Minimum Standards for Aeronautical Activities* at the Abilene Regional Airport;

WHEREAS, a need has arisen to amend the *Minimum Standards for Aeronautical Activities* as per the attached Exhibit A.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 2: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.

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MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR AERONAUTICAL ACTIVITIES
AT THE ABILENE REGIONAL AIRPORT

Amend the *MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR AERONAUTICAL ACTIVITIES* at the Abilene Regional Airport, dated March 10, 1988, as follows:

On Page 11, Section E. AIRCRAFT FUELS AND OIL DISPENSING SERVICE, remove sub-paragraph 1. Statement of Concept

An aircraft fuels and oil dispensing operator is a person, firm, or corporation engaged in the sale and into-plane delivery of recognized brands of aviation fuels, lubricants, and other related aviation petroleum products. Granting of this aeronautical service shall not constitute an exclusive right.

Replace with:

E. AIRCRAFT FUELS AND OIL DISPENSING SERVICE

1. Statement of Concept

An aircraft fuels and oil dispensing operator is a person, firm, or corporation engaged in the sale and into-plane delivery of recognized brands of aviation fuels, lubricants, and other related aviation petroleum products. **The into-plane delivery of fuels, lubricants, or other related aviation petroleum products may be performed by the operators' personnel and/or by individuals on a self-serve basis.** Granting of this aeronautical service shall not constitute an exclusive right.

On Page 12-A, Section E. AIRCRAFT FUELS AND OIL DISPENSING SERVICE, add the following to paragraph (g):

Should the operator choose to allow self-serve of fuel, lubricants, or other related aviation petroleum products by the customer, then the Commercial Liability Insurance must acknowledge that their insurance covers the self-serve activity.
