

RESOLUTION NO. 7-1995

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene desires to provide for a safe learning environment for the middle school students of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide positive impact on student perception of Police Officers; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the middle school students of Abilene be educated as to the harmful effects of drug and alcohol abuse, be provided with information regarding crime prevention techniques, and other factors that affect their lives;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: That the city hereby approves the submission of a grant application for a total of \$189,962.00 to the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, U.S. Department of Justice, the grant to be used to fund the Middle School Resource Officer Program.

Part 2: That of the total amount of \$189,962.00, \$49,384.00 in matching funds will be provided by the City, as required by the provisions of the grant application.


Part 3: That the approved manpower of the Abilene Police Department be increased by two officers, pending approval of Grant funding.


Part 4: That the City Manager is authorized to sign the grant application on behalf of the City of Abilene.
