

RESOLUTION NO. 14-1996

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS REQUESTING THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO PROVIDE NECESSARY FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTING OVERHEADS ALONG U.S. HIGHWAY 287 IN WICHITA FALLS.

WHEREAS, Interstate Highway 44 terminates in downtown Wichita Falls and can be improved by an overhead freeway along U.S. Hwy. 287 to provide linkages to U.S. Hwy. 277 and other highways that connect to the National Highway System; and,

WHEREAS, U.S. Hwy. 277 from Abilene to Wichita Falls is four lanes for approximately 85 miles of the 150 mile distance between the two cities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene agrees an elevated highway project will improve the corridor that connects Abilene to Oklahoma City; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


- Part 1. That the City of Abilene supports the request that the Texas Transportation Commission fund an elevated highway from I-44 to U.S. Highways 287 and 82 in Wichita Fall, Texas.
- Part 2. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed and open to the public as required by law.
- Part 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
