

RESOLUTION NO. 15-1996

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT TO WEST TEXAS UTILITIES COMPANY FOR RELOCATING POWER TRANSMISSION FACILITIES WHICH ARE WITHIN THE ANTILLEY ROAD WIDENING PROJECT LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has designed a project to widen Antilley Road, between Buffalo Gap Road and Twin Oaks Drive; and,

WHEREAS, the construction of this project will conflict with the location of an existing 138 kv power line structure, and 16 existing street lights, owned and operated by the West Texas Utilities Company; and,

WHEREAS, the West Texas Utilities Company has designed a relocation project for the 138 kv power line and will retire the 16 existing street lights, to eliminate the referenced conflict; and,

WHEREAS, the West Texas Utilities Company has provided the City a cost estimate for construction of the referenced relocation in the amount of Thirty One Thousand One Hundred and Sixty Eight Dollars and 44/100 (\$31,168.44); and,

WHEREAS, the West Texas Utilities Company has provided the City a cost estimate for the retirement of the 16 existing street lights in the amount of One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen Dollars and 55/100 (\$1,918.55); and,

WHEREAS, the West Texas Utilities Company has requested payment in this amount for the work to eliminate the conflicts affecting the reconstruction project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has contracted with the Texas Department of Transportation to pay for any costs associated with the relocation of utilities made necessary by the construction of the Antilley Road widening project; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That assurance is hereby given that adequate funds have been appropriated and are available in the estimated amount of Thirty One Thousand One Hundred and Sixty Eight Dollars and 44/100 (\$31,168.44) for payment to the West Texas Utilities Company for the actual cost incurred in the relocation of the 138 kv power line.

PART 2: That assurance is hereby given that adequate funds have been appropriated and are available in the estimated amount of One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen Dollars and 55/100 (\$1918.55) for payment to the West Texas Utilities Company for the actual cost incurred in the retirement of 16 street lights.

PART 3: That payment will be made by the City to the West Texas Utilities Company on the basis of an itemized invoice of the actual cost incurred.


PART 4: The Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


