

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, IN SUPPORT OF THE REGIONAL SOLID WASTE GRANT APPLICATION - CATEGORY 2 LOCAL ENFORCEMENT.

WHEREAS, the West Central Texas Council of Governments (WCTCOG) in cooperation with the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) has announced availability of Municipal Solid Waste Grant Funding for Fiscal 1996 and issued a Request for Project Proposals; and

WHEREAS, Taylor County plans to file a grant application in the amount of \$39,602 and needs support and the financial commitment of the City of Abilene and Jones County to set up an effective interlocal campaign against illegal dumping efforts; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, in order to support this Taylor County grant proposal, needs to commit to three (3) consecutive years of funding for a total of \$48,460 to ensure the success of the program; and,

WHEREAS, the WCTCOG requests that the Abilene City Council, by resolution, indicates support of this application; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 1: That the City Council supports the application to be submitted by Taylor County in pursuit of grant funding through the WCTCOG's Local Enforcement Program.

Part 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any necessary grant related documents.


Part 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
