

RESOLUTION NO. 17-1999

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Article 6701j-1, as amended, currently Transportation Code Sec. 723, et. seq., declares that the establishment, development, and maintenance of a program of traffic safety in Texas is a vital governmental purpose and function of the State and its legal and political subdivisions; and,

WHEREAS, the Governor of Texas has named the Engineer-Director of the Department as his representative to administer the Texas Traffic Safety Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Engineer-Director has formulated a program of projects for the current fiscal year called the Summer STEP Waves, and the United States Department of Transportation (US DOT) has approved the Summer STEP Waves and authorized the Department to proceed with approved implementation in accordance with approved procedures; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and its Police Department desire to implement a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 1: That the City hereby approves the submission of a grant application for a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.

Part 2: That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to sign the grant application and contract on behalf of the City of Abilene.


Part 3: That this Resolution shall take effective immediately from and after its passage.


