

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, MAKING APPLICATION FOR AMMENDMENT TO A WATER RIGHT CURRENTLY ISSUED BY THE TEXAS NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION COMMISSION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the State of Texas through the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) requires that a Water Right be held for specific water diversions from surface reservoirs in the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City currently holds Certificate of Adjudication No. 12-4161A, (Water Right) which authorizes specific water diversions from Fort Phantom Hill Reservoir, that expires December 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to file an **APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO A WATER RIGHT** that allows the City of Abilene to continue specific water diversions for Fort Phantom Hill Reservoir as currently authorized in Certificate of Adjudication No. 12-4161A.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 1: That the City Director of Water Utilities, or his designee, is hereby authorized to file an **APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO A WATER RIGHT** that will allow the City to divert water for specific uses from Fort Phantom Hill Reservoir.


Part 2: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
