A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
APPOINTING VARIOUS ELECTION OFFICIALS, AND FIXING THEIR RATE OF
COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council has previously ordered an election for Mayor
and Council Places 3 and 4 for May 1, 1999.

PART 2: The maximum number of clerks for each voting precinct shall be three, and each judge shall attempt to appoint one clerk fluent both in English and Spanish.

PART 3: The rate of compensation shall be Five and 15/100ths (\$5.15) Dollars per hour; provided, however, that each presiding judge delivering returns of the election shall be paid an additional Twenty-Five and 00/100ths (\$25.00) Dollars, for that service.

PART 4: Early voting ballots shall be counted by the Early Voting Ballot Board, as provided for by law.

PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.

PART 6: That the Terms of this appointment shall be for the May 1st election.


