

RESOLUTION NO. 15-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE ON MAY 6, 2000 AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR JUNE 3, 2000 RUNOFF ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of February, A.D. 2000, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution and proclamation, called an election to be held in said City on the 6th day of May 2000, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of said city, for the purpose of electing persons to serve in Council Places 1 & 2, and a special election for the purpose of electing a person to serve an unexpired term in Council Place 3 and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly canvassed the returns of such elections and has ascertained the results thereof; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene finds and declares the results of such elections as per the attached Exhibit "A".

PART 2: It appearing that Norm Archibald received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Council Place 1; and

PART 3: It appearing that no candidate received the majority of votes cast for the office of Council Places 2 and 3; runoff elections will be held on Saturday, June 3, 2000 as provided in Resolution #2-2000 in accordance with the provisions of the applicable laws of the State of Texas; and

PART 4: That the City Council of the City of Abilene has established procedures superceding Section 1, "City Elections" of Resolution #2-2000 for the June 3 runoff elections as per the attached Exhibit "B".


PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

Saturday voting will be held at the Taylor County Courthouse May 20, 2000, from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.


