RESOLUTION NO. 16-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING VARIOUS ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR THE JUNE 3, 2000 CITY GENERAL AND SPECIAL RUN OFF ELECTIONS, AND FIXING THEIR RATE OF COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council has previously ordered an election for Council Places 1 and 2 and the unexpired term of Council Place 3 for May 6, 2000, and

WHEREAS, no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for Council Place 2 in the General Election, and no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for Council Place 3 in the Special Election held the 6th day of May, 2000, and,

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council has ordered a General Runoff Election for Council Place 2 and a Special Runoff Election for the unexpired term of Council Place 3 for June 3, 2000, now therefore;

- PART 2: The maximum number of clerks for each voting precinct shall be two, and each judge shall attempt to appoint one clerk fluent both in English and Spanish.
- PART 3: The rate of compensation shall be Five and 15/100ths (\$5.15) Dollars per hour; provided, however, that each presiding judge delivering returns of the election shall be paid an additional Twenty-Five and 00/100ths (\$25.00) Dollars, for that service.
- PART 4: Early voting ballots shall be counted by the Early Voting Ballot Board, as provided for by law.
- PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.
- PART 6: That the Terms of this appointment shall be for the June 3, 2000 City runoff elections.
