

RESOLUTION NO. 28-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING LOCATION OF POLLING PLACES, ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY BRANCH AND MOBILE VOTING LOCATIONS, APPOINTING VARIOUS ELECTION OFFICIALS, FIXING THEIR RATE OF COMPENSATION, PROVIDING FOR A PROCLAMATION NOTICE AND PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON NOVEMBER 7, 2000 IN CONJUNCTION WITH TAYLOR COUNTY'S GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council has previously ordered by Resolution a special election for November 7, 2000, to provide for voting for or against the following proposition:

For or Against: Adding fluoride to the City of Abilene water supply and thereby recommending the repeal of the 1964 Ordinance No. 127, which prohibited adding fluoride.

WHEREAS, Section 3 of said Resolution authorized establishing voting and polling places, appointment of Election Officials, Establishing Temporary Branch Locations, Days, Dates and Times for Early Voting, Establishing Mobile Voting Locations, Days, Dates, and Times for Early Voting and Providing for a Proclamation Notice and Publication of Notice of said Election; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 2: The maximum number of clerks for each voting precinct shall be five, and each judge shall attempt to appoint one clerk fluent both in English and Spanish.

PART 3: The rate of compensation shall be Five and 15/100ths (\$5.15) Dollars per hour; provided, however, that each presiding judge delivering returns of the election shall be paid an additional Twenty-Five and 00/100ths (\$25.00) Dollars, for that service.

PART 4: Early voting ballots shall be counted by the Early Voting Ballot Board, as provided for by law.

PART 5: The Mayor is authorized to make proclamation as shown in Exhibit A to this Resolution of said City election and give notice thereof, and a copy of said proclamation shall be sufficient notice of said election. Notice of the time and places of holding said election shall be given by publication of such notice in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Abilene at least thirty (30) days prior to the day of such election.

PART 6: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.

PART 7: That the Terms of this appointment shall be for the November 7 election.






