

RESOLUTION NO. 34-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FLUORIDATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FLUORIDATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas held an election as authorized by law, on November 7, 2000 in conjunction with the general election to provide for voting for or against the following proposition:

For or Against: Adding fluoride to the City of Abilene water supply and thereby recommending the repeal of the 1964 Ordinance No. 127, which prohibited adding fluoride; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the voting public voted for the proposition; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene must now procure a source for the necessities of fluoridating all water supplies within the City of Abilene distribution system to a total fluoride concentration of parts per million as recommended by the Texas Department of Health; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1: That the City of Abilene make application to participate in the Texas Department of Health Fluoridation Project.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate the terms and conditions of any fluoridation agreements or contracts and execute all necessary documents with the Texas Department of Health if said application is approved.


