

RESOLUTION NO. 37-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PAY INCREASES OF ABILENE POLICE OFFICERS AS SET FORTH HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Abilene Police Officers' Association has previously filed a petition calling for a Charter election to set their minimum salaries, authorize pay increases in April 2001 and October 2001, and other binding commitments on the city on behalf of all police officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Manager to review the officers' compensation proposal in lieu of an election; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has completed said review; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City of Abilene does agree to the following police monthly base pay amounts:


SECTION 3: That the Abilene Police Officers' Association will formally withdraw, in writing, their petition request for a Charter election.
