

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Article 6701j-1, as amended, currently Transportation Code Sec. 723, et. Seq., declares that the establishment, development, and maintenance of a program of traffic safety in Texas is a vital governmental purpose and function of the State and its legal and political subdivisions; and,

WHEREAS, the Government of Texas has named the Engineer-Director of the Department as his representative to administer the Texas Traffic Safety Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Engineer-Director has formulated a program of projects for the next three fiscal years called the 2000-2002 STEP Waves, and the United States Department of Transportation (US DOT) has approved the 2000-2002 STEP Waves and authorized the Department to proceed with approved implementation in accordance with approved procedures; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and its Police Department desire to implement a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, that:


- Part 1. The City of Abilene hereby approves the submission of a grant application for a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.


