

RESOLUTION NO. 26-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY ("TEA-21") FUNDS AND LOCAL FUNDS FOR THE ABILENE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN TRAIL SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene will guarantee the funding needed to match any awards made by the Texas Department of Transportation for a bicycle and pedestrian trail system, and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene supports activities that contribute to the livelihood of communities, promotes the quality of the environment and enhances the aesthetics of our roadways, and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene encourages a diverse mode of travel.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

PART 1: TEA-21 funds, along with local dollars and eligible in-kind contributions are hereby authorized to be used for the development of a bicycle and pedestrian trail system.


PART 2: The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to sign all relevant documents pertaining to the TEA-21 application.


