- PART 4: Early voting ballots shall be counted by the Early Voting Ballot Board, as provided for by law.
- PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.
- PART 6: That the terms of this appointment shall be for the November 6th election and run off election, if necessary.
