A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS TO SERVE THE DYESS AFB NORTH ENTRANCE.

WHEREAS, the need for transportation improvements to accommodate truck and heavy equipment access to the Dyess AFB north entrance was identified in the Abilene Metropolitan Planning Organization public involvement process for the 2000-2025 Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, a task force convened by the Texas Department of Transportation District Office at the request of the Metropolitan Planning Organization determined that improvements should be made to a route consisting of Military Drive between the Dyess AFB north entrance and FM 3438 and FM 3438 between Military Drive and I-20; and

WHEREAS, the improvements to FM 3438 and Military Drive will also improve access to the Dyess AFB main entrance, the Five Points Business Park, and the Texas Department of Transportation's new Abilene Area office; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City of Abilene supports the proposal to improve Military Drive and FM 3438 to enhance truck and heavy equipment access to the Dyess AFB north entrance.

PART 2: That the City of Abilene supports the efforts to seek special consideration by the Texas Transportation Commission for funding the necessary improvements.
