

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR WAIVER OF APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene desires to provide for a safe environment for its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene desires to provide positive impact on juvenile offenders within its jurisdiction; and,


WHEREAS, the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, has made available \$30,727 in the form of Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant to the City of Abilene and local jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, that:


- Part 1. The City of Abilene hereby waives the right to apply for said Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant.
- Part 2. The City of Abilene waives said funds and hereby authorizes these funds be made available to the Taylor County Juvenile Probation Department.
- Part 3. The City of Abilene agrees to participate in the planning and implementation of services provided through this funding mechanism by active participation in the Juvenile Crime Enforcement Coalition as established by the Community Justice Council.
- Part 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
