RESOLUTION NO. 38-2003

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF GRANT APPLICATIONS WITH THE WEST CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (WCTCOG) FOR REGIONAL SOLID WASTE GRANTS PROGRAM GRANTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ABILENE IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATIONS; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED, THE CITY OF ABILENE WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE WCTCOG. THE TEXAS NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION COMMISSION, AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the WCTCOG is directed by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission to administer solid waste grant funds for implementation of the WCTCOG's adopted regional solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- That the City Manager is authorized to request grant funding under the WCTCOG Request for Application of the Regional Solid Waste Grants Program and act on behalf of the City in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contact and grant project that may result.
- PART 2: That if the project is funded, the City will comply with the grant requirements of the WCTCOG, the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission, and the State of Texas.
- That the grant funds and grant funded equipment or facilities will be used only PART 3: for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
- PART 4: That activities will comply with and support the adopted regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.
- PART 5: That the City is not in arrears in payment of any municipal solid waste fee owed to the State of Texas.
 - PART 6: This resolution is effective immediately.
