

RESOLUTION NO. 39-2003

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS  
NAMING THE HARGESHEIMER WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Abilene voted on August 10, 1985 to participate in the construction of the O.H. Ivie Reservoir; and the reservoir was completed in 1990; and

**WHEREAS**, in January 2000, the City of Abilene began the design and construction of pump stations, ground storage tanks, a 52-mile pipeline, an electrical distribution system, and a communications system to pump O.H. Ivie Reservoir water into a state-of-the art technologically advanced water treatment plant; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2003, the City of Abilene celebrated the completion of the Lake Ivie Pipeline Project and the Water Treatment Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2003, the City of Abilene officially named the Ivie Water Treatment Plant as the Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plant.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**


**PART 1:** That the Abilene City Council celebrates the completion of the Lake Ivie Pipeline Project.


