

RESOLUTION NO. 46-2003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
AMENDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL TO THE OFFICE  
OF NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES.

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2003, the City Council established an Advisory Council  
to provide guidance and support to the Office of Neighborhood Services (ONS); and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to enlarge the membership of  
the Advisory Council from seven to nine members.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the ONS Advisory Council shall be composed of nine (9) members  
appointed by the Mayor of the City of Abilene with approval of the City Council, four of  
whom shall represent the following entities:

Abilene Christian University  
Hardin-Simmons University  
McMurry University  
The Council of Neighborhood Associations

The remaining five members shall be at-large from among relevant stakeholders in the  
community with an interest or expertise in neighborhoods. Members shall serve for a  
term of two years and until their successors are appointed and qualified, provided that of  
the initial appointments four members shall be appointed for a term of only one year.


PART 2: That the Advisory Council shall provide guidance and support to the  
Office of Neighborhood Services in carrying out the ONS objectives and the  
recommendations contained in the Neighborhood Development Services strategy of the  
ACE Task Force report.

PART 3: That the Advisory Council shall adopt such by-laws as it deems  
necessary and appropriate for the efficient and effective operation of the Council.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its  
passage.
