

RESOLUTION NO. 15-2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE ON MAY 15, 2004 AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR JUNE 19, 2004 RUNOFF ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of February, A.D. 2004, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution and proclamation, ordered a General election to be held in said City on the 15th day of May, 2004, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of said city, for the purpose of electing persons to serve in Council Places 5 & 6; and

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, A.D. 2004, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution and proclamation ordered a Special election to be held in conjunction with the City's General Election on the 15th day of May, 2004, for the purpose of electing persons to serve in the unexpired terms of Council Place 1 and Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly canvassed the returns of such elections and has ascertained the results thereof; now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene finds and declares the results of such elections as per the attached Exhibit "A".

PART 2: It appearing that Laura Moore received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Council Place 6; and Norm Archibald received the majority of votes cast in said Special election for the office of the unexpired term of Mayor; and


PART 3: It appearing that no candidate received the majority of votes cast for the office of Council Places 1 and 5; runoff elections will be held on Saturday, June 19, 2004 as provided in Resolution #'s 1-2004 and 5-2004 in accordance with the provisions of the applicable laws of the State of Texas; and

PART 4: That the City Council of the City of Abilene has established procedures superceding Section 1, "City Elections" of Resolution #'s 1-2004 and #5-2004 for the June 19 runoff elections as per the attached Exhibit "B".

PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.



ELECTION PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, did on the 12th day of February, 2004, pass a Resolution ordering the General Election in the City of Abilene for Council Places 5 and 6 and on the 11th day of March, 2004, pass a resolution ordering a Special Election to be held in conjunction with the General Election to fill the unexpired terms of Council Place 1 and Mayor, said elections to be held on May 15, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas did establish a runoff date of June 19, 2004 if necessary for said elections, and it having been determined that said runoff elections are necessary; now, therefore,

I, GRADY BARR, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, do hereby proclaim said elections and give notice thereof of said elections to be held on June 19, 2004, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the locations below set out:


Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on June 11, 2004.
