## RESOLUTION NO. 16-2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING VARIOUS ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR THE JUNE 19, 2004 CITY GENERAL AND SPECIAL RUN OFF ELECTIONS, AND FIXING THEIR RATE OF COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council has previously ordered for May 15, 2004, a General Election for Council Places 5 and 6 and a Special Election for the unexpired terms of Council Place 1 and Mayor; and,

WHEREAS, no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for Council Place 5 in the General Election, and no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for Council Place 1 in the Special Election held the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council has ordered a General Runoff Election for Council Place 5 and a Special Runoff Election for the unexpired term of Council Place 1 for June 19, 2004, now therefore;
