

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AFFIRMING THE REVERSION OF WOODS PLACE (FORMERLY POPLAR STREET) AS A PUBLIC STREET.

WHEREAS, by the Flat Acres Addition, platted of record on February 1, 1959, a 60 foot wide public right-of-way identified as Poplar Street was dedicated; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 69-1984, this right-of-way was renamed as Woods Place; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 32-1985, the south 580 feet of the Woods Place right-of-way was abandoned conditionally; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney's office has determined that under the conditions of Ordinance No. 32-1985, Woods Place can revert to the City of Abilene as a public street; and

WHEREAS, by letter from Vincent Johnson, the Abilene Psychiatric Center has requested that the right-of-way of Woods Place be officially returned to public street status; and now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: The full length and width of the Woods Place right-of-way that was conditionally abandoned by Ordinance No. 32-1985, is now public street right-of-way and subject to all rules and regulations pertaining to public street right-of-way.

PART 2: Private improvements or other assets in the right-of-way of Woods Place shall be removed from the right-of-way at the owner's expense within 90 days.

PART 3: The Public Works Director shall notify the abutting property owners and the Central Appraisal District of the change in status of Woods Place to a public street.
