

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPROVING THE RECERTIFICATION OF ABILENE NEIGHBORHOODS IN PROGRESS, INC., AS A COMMUNITY BASED DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION (CBDO).

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has designated the City of Abilene as an Entitlement City eligible to receive formula funding from the Community Development Block Grant Program by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1994, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene is awarded an annual entitlement under the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the primary objective of the City's community development program is to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment, and to expand economic opportunities principally for persons of low- and moderate-income; and

WHEREAS, Abilene Neighborhoods in Progress, Inc. has previously been certified as a CBDO and has satisfied the requirements to be recertified as a CBDO and as such will undertake activities to provide a benefit to low- and moderate-income persons;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, THAT:

Part 1. Having met the requirements for recertification, the City of Abilene approves recertification and recognizes Abilene Neighborhoods in Progress as a CBDO for the purpose of improving the physical, social or economic environment of its geographic area of operation by addressing one or more critical problems in the area, with particular attention to the needs of low- to moderate-income persons.

Part 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
