

RESOLUTION NO. 17-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL/SPECIAL/JOINT ELECTIONS HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE ON MAY 13, 2006.

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of February, A.D. 2006, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution and proclamation, ordered a General/Joint and Bond election to be held in said City on the 13th day of May, 2006, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of said city, for the purpose of electing persons to serve in Council Places 1 & 2; and

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of March, A.D. 2006, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution and proclamation ordered a Special election to be held in conjunction with the City's General/Joint and Bond Elections on the 13th day of May, 2006, for the purpose of electing a person to serve in the unexpired term of Council Place 4; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly canvassed the returns of such elections and has ascertained the results thereof; now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene finds and declares the results of the General/Joint/Special election as per the attached Exhibit "A"; and

PART 2: It appearing that Sam Chase received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Council Place 1 and Joe Spano received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Council Place 2; and Celia Davis received the majority of votes cast in said Special election for the office of the unexpired term of Council Place 4; and


PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
