RESOLUTION NO. 29–2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON NOVEMBER 7, 2006, FOR A NON-BINDING REFERENDUM FOR VOTER CONSIDERATION OF BANNING SMOKING IN ALL PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF ABILENE TEXAS; AND PROVIDING FOR A PROCLAMATION NOTICE AND PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the U. S. Surgeon General recently released a report focusing on the effects of secondhand smoke. Secondhand smoke is composed of sidestream smoke (the smoke released from the burning end of a cigarette) and exhaled mainstream smoke (the smoke exhaled by the smoker). Secondand smoke has been designated as a known human carcinogen by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, the National Toxicology Program, and the International Agency for Research on Cancer, and an occupational carcinogen by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health; and

WHEREAS, said report found that scientific evidence indicates there is no risk-free level of exposure to secondhand smoke and that breathing even a little secondhand smoke can be harmful to your health; and,

WHEREAS, accordingly, the City Council recognizes that secondhand smoke poses a serious public health hazard, that nonsmokers need protection from secondhand smoke exposure and that therefore, regulation by the City Council of the burning of tobacco in public places and places of employment is imperative in order to protect the public health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Abilene;

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to hold a non-binding referendum to allow the voters of the City of Abilene to voice their opinion if they support the council enacting an ordinance banning smoking in all public places and places of employment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas, is authorized by law to hold such election on November 7, 2006 in conjunction with the state and county elections; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That an election is, and the same is hereby ordered to be held within the jurisdiction of the City of Abilene, Texas, on the 7th day of November, 2006, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, and a contract between the City and Taylor County for election services. Such election shall be held for the following purposes:

To provide for voting for or against the following proposition:

Do you support the City Council adopting an ordinance prohibiting smoking in all public places and places of employment?

For Against

PART 2: The election called by this resolution shall be held in accordance with the requirements for bilingual elections as set forth in the Voting Rights Act amendments for 1975 (42 USC 1973aa-1a) and in Section 272.001 of the Election Code. All election forms and material shall be printed in both English and Spanish, and bilingual oral assistance shall be made available within the requirements of the law.

PART 3: Said election shall be held in the election precincts, and voting shall be conducted on November 7, 2006, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the City's regular polling places shown below:

PART 4. That all resident, qualified electors of said City shall be entitled to vote at said election.

PART 5: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby designates that the direct recording electronic voting machines shall be used for voting at the foregoing election precincts and electronic counting devices and equipment shall be used for counting the ballots in this joint general election to be held on November 7, 2006, said system having been previously approved and utilized by the Taylor County Commissioners for conducting Share\legal\election\2006\smoking Page 6 of 7

their elections. The City Council further determines that all early ballots voted in person and by mail shall be voted by ballots to be counted by the electronic voting system. The Taylor County Plaza is hereby designated as the Central Counting Station for the automatic counting and tabulating of ballots. The City Secretary and the Taylor County Election Administrator are hereby designated as Early Voting Clerks for the City, and the Taylor County Elections Administrator is designated to supervise the early voting.

- **PART 6.** That notice of said election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Resolution at the City Hall and in each of the election precincts in said City, not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date set for said election; and a substantial copy of this Resolution also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in said City, the date of the first publication to be not less than fourteen (14) day prior to the date set for said election.
- **PART 7**. That the Mayor shall make proclamation of said City's election and give notice thereof, and a copy of this Resolution shall be sufficient notice of said election. Notice of the time and places of holding said election shall be given by publication of such notice in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Abilene at least thirty (30) days to the date of such election.
- PART 8. That said election shall be conducted in all respects in accordance with the Texas Election Code, and all resident qualified electors of the City shall be entitled to vote at said election. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act and the Texas Election Code, each polling place shall be provided at least one voting system equipped for individuals with disabilities.
- **PART 9**. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as indicated below.
