A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS ORDERING A BOND ELECTION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON MAY 13, 2006 TO BE HELD IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE JOINT ABILENE CITY COUNCIL, ABILENE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND LYTLE LAKE WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION PRECINCTS; LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES; EARLY VOTING; PROVIDING FOR THE PROPOSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A PROCLAMATION NOTICE AND PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, this City Council of said City deems it advisable to call the election hereinafter ordered; and

WHEREAS, said election shall be held in conjunction with and as a part of a joint election for the election of City of Abilene City Council members, and for the election of members of the Board of Trustees of Abilene Independent School District, and the Lytle Lake Water Control and Improvement District Directors; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that holding the hereinafter called election is in the public interest; and that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1. That an election shall be held on May 13, 2006 in said City on the following setout PROPOSITIONS in Part 5.

PART 2. Said election shall be held in the election precincts and voting shall be conducted on May 13, 2006 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the City's regular polling places shown below:

Early voting by personal appearance shall also be conducted at the following temporary branch polling places, on the dates and during the hours as specified below:

The location to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail are to be sent shall be the Taylor County Election Administrator's Office, P. O. Box 3318, Abilene, Texas, 79604.

PART 3. That all resident, qualified electors of said City shall be entitled to vote at said election.

PART 4. That notice of said election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Resolution at the City Hall and in each of the election precincts in said City, not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date set for said election; and a substantial copy of this Resolution also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in said City, the date of the first publication to be not less than fourteen (14) day prior to the date set for said election.

PART 5. That at said election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO.1

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$19,165,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing and improving the City's streets, together with traffic improvements, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,260,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing and equipping improvements at the City's Airport, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$4,180,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing and improving the stormwater and drainage system together with the acquisition of land in connection therewith, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 4

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,100,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing, improving and equipping the City's Zoo, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 5

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,125,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing, improving and equipping Lake Fort Phantom Hill Park/Boat Ramps/Docks and Dyess Recreation Area, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 6

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$690,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing and improving the City's sidewalks, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PROPOSITION NO. 7

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,300,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing, improving and equipping ballfield lighting and other improvements at City parks, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

PART 6. That the official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:
