

RESOLUTION No. 41-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF A CUSTOMER FACILITY CHARGE AT ABILENE REGIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene has undertaken a capital improvement program to facilitate major customer service improvements at Abilene Regional Airport (Airport); and

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene operates, maintains and develops the Airport, in part with federal grants, state grants, passenger facility charges and user fees; and

WHEREAS, Customer Facility Charges (CFC) have become a common financing tool for landside improvements at airports: and

WHEREAS, the rental car companies operating at the Airport have agreed to a CFC to pay for the planning, design and construction of various landside facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City shall establish and periodically adjust as required, a daily CFC upon each airport rental car companies' customer's rental contract.

SECTION 2: The CFC will be collected on a daily basis for all cars rented for twenty-four or fewer hours for the first transaction day, and every twenty-four hours for each transaction day thereafter.

SECTION 3: The CFC shall initially be established at \$3.00 per transaction day.

SECTION 4: The CFC will be collected by all rental car companies at the Airport.

SECTION 5: The CFC collected by the rental car companies shall be held in trust by the rental car companies for the benefit of the Airport and shall be remitted monthly to the City of Abilene in accordance with procedures established by the City of Abilene Director of Finance.

SECTION 6: Rental car companies and their agents hold only a possessory interest in the CFC, and no legal or equitable interest.

SECTION 7: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon execution, and the CFC referenced herein shall be collected commencing February 1, 2007.
