

RESOLUTION NO. 7-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED LICENSING AND OPERATION OF THE ABILENE POLICE ACADEMY.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene created the Abilene Police Academy in 1962 to provide the requisite training for cadets entering the Abilene Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, through the continuous operation of the Abilene Police Academy, 611 cadets have successfully entered the Abilene Police Department in service to the citizens of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission of Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Education (TCLEOSE) is the state agency responsible for licensing and superintendence of police officers and police academies within the state of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, TCLEOSE requires each academy to renew the licensing and accreditation on a five year basis; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of Abilene, Texas has provided funding and support for the Abilene Police Academy since its inception and proudly supports the efforts of the Abilene Police Academy to maintain the Academy license and accreditation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene supports the continued licensing and operation of the Abilene Policy Academy and authorizes the City Manager or his designee to sign any and all necessary documents to obtain reaccreditation of the Academy pursuant to TCLEOSE standards.


PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
