

RESOLUTION # 13-2008

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A  
RED LIGHT CAMERA CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature, 80<sup>th</sup> Session, enacted SB 1119, effective September 1, 2007, creating Chapter 707 of the Texas Transportation Code, establishing requirements for photographic traffic signal enforcement systems; and,


WHEREAS, Chapter 707 of the Texas Transportation Code calls for the establishment of a citizens advisory committee, consisting of one person appointed by each member of the governing body to make recommendations to the City related to the installation and operation of a photographic traffic signal enforcement system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS THAT:


- Section 1. The City Council hereby creates a seven member red light camera citizens advisory committee, with one member appointed by the Mayor and one member appointed by each City Councilmember.
- Section 2. Committee members shall serve an initial term of six months; if Council determines a need for further study, members may be reappointed to one year terms.
- Section 3. The committee shall advise the City on the installation and operation of a photographic traffic signal enforcement system established by Chapter 707 of the Texas Transportation Code, or any alternative to the system likely to reduce the number of Red Light violations and improve safety.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption and it is accordingly so ordered.


