RESOLUTION NO. 19-2008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS CANVASSING THE RETURNS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL CALLED ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE ON MAY 10, 2008.

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of February, A.D. 2008, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution, ordered a General Election and Special Election to be held in said City on the 10th day of May 2008, in accordance with state law and the provisions of the Charter of said City, for the purpose of electing persons to serve as Mayor, Council Places 3 & 4 and Special Election For/Against the Youth Sports Complex Proposition and:

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly canvassed the returns of the election and has ascertained the results thereof; now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene finds and declares the results of the General/Special election as per the attached Exhibit "A"; and

PART 2: It appears that Norm Archibald received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Mayor and Anthony Williams received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Council Place 3; and Robert O. Briley received the majority of votes cast in said General election for the office of Council Place 4; and

PART 3: It also appears that the Special Election For/Against the Youth Sports Complex Proposition failed; and

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
