

RESOLUTION NO. 25-2008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR A LOCAL
TRANSPORTATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, in 2006, the City through the Capital Improvements Program, approved funding in the amount of \$180,000 to be used to encourage further development of areas that meet the City's infill development goals; and,

WHEREAS, the area generally located along Loop 322 between Maple and Industrial has seen recent development and growth in a previously undeveloped area of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the residential, commercial, and educational developments in the area have brought increased vehicular traffic that necessitates reconfiguration of the off-ramps that bring vehicular traffic to the developments of the area to assure the safety of the residents and customers as well as continued development; and,

WHEREAS, the State and City agree that the off-ramp relocation is in the best interest of the residential, commercial and educational development in the area and are each committed to financially support said relocation; and,

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2008 the City Council authorized the expenditure of \$60,000 of the infill development project funds that were budgeted through the Capital Improvements Program in 2006, for a portion of the cost of an off-ramp relocation project on Loop 322 between Maple and Industrial;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, hereby authorizes the City's participation in a Local Transportation Project Advanced Funding Agreement with the State of Texas.

PART 2: That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign a Local Transportation Project Advanced Funding Agreement with the State of Texas and any necessary auxiliary agreements directly related thereto.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
