

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM – IMPAIRED DRIVER IMMOBILIZATION “IDM”

WHEREAS, Texas Transportation Code Sec. 723, declares that the establishment, and maintenance of a program of traffic safety in Texas is a vital governmental purpose and function of the State and its legal and political subdivisions; and,

WHEREAS, Texas has named the Engineer-Director of the Texas Department of Transportation as its representative to administer the Texas Traffic Safety Program; and,

WHEREAS, The Engineer-Director has formulated a program of projects for the next fiscal year called the STEP IDM Grant 2008, and the United States Department of Transportation (US DOT) has approved the STEP IDM Grant 2008 and authorized the Department to proceed with approved implementation in accordance with the approved procedures; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and its Police Department desire to implement a Selective Traffic Enforcement Impaired Driver Immobilization Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 1. That the City of Abilene hereby approves the submission of a grant application for a Selective Traffic Enforcement Impaired Driver Immobilization Program.
