



**CITY OF ABILENE  
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE  
COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE  
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, at its meeting to commence at 8:30 A.M. on December 16, 2010, at its regular meeting place in the City Hall, 555 Walnut, Abilene, Texas, tentatively proposes to adopt an ordinance authorizing the issuance of interest bearing certificates of obligation, in one or more series, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 for paying all or a portion of the City's contractual obligations incurred in connection with:

- (i) constructing, reconstructing and improving streets, sidewalks and alleys including related drainage, signalization, landscaping, lighting and signage;
- (ii) constructing and equipping improvements, including environmental remediation, to the fire department training facility;
- (iii) constructing and equipping improvements to the police department firing range;
- (iv) constructing and equipping improvements to the City zoo;
- (v) constructing and equipping parks and recreation improvements, including improvements to the Rose Park Tennis Center;
- (vi) constructing and equipping improvements to Maxwell Golf Course; and
- (vii) legal, fiscal and engineering fees in connection with such projects. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such certificates of obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law and from a pledge of limited surplus revenues of the City's waterworks and sewer system, remaining after payment of all operation and maintenance expenses thereof, and all debt service, reserve, and other requirements in connection with all of the City's revenue bonds or other obligations (now or hereafter outstanding), which are payable from all or any part of the net revenues of the City's waterworks and sewer system. The certificates of obligation are to be issued, and this notice is given, under and pursuant to the provisions of V.T.C.A., Local Government Code, Subchapter C of Chapter 271.
