

RESOLUTION NO. 18 -2015

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING A RESOLUTION CALLING A BOND ELECTION AND IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE JOINT ABILENE CITY COUNCIL, WYLIE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND CITY OF IMPACT ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN SAID CITY; PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT AND THE GIVING NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND ENACTING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "City Council") of the City of Abilene, Texas (the "City") adopted resolution number 16-2015 on February 26, 2015 ("Resolution No. 16-2015") calling a bond election (the "Bond Election") to be held within the City;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas adopted resolution number 16-2015 on February 26, 2015 calling a joint election with Wylie Independent School District and the City of Impact;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 16-2015 sets forth the Election Day polling places and early voting polling places for the Bond Election;

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Elections Administrator has notified the City that the election day polling places for the Bond Election have changed;

WHEREAS, this City Council hereby finds and determines that Resolution No. 16-2015 should be amended to set forth the revised list of election day polling places for the Bond Election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and declares that the meeting at which this Resolution is considered is open to the public as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1. Resolution No. 16-2015 is hereby amended by amending Exhibit A thereof as set forth in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to provide for the election day polling places.


Section 2. A substantial copy of Resolution No. 16-2015, as amended herein, shall serve as the notice of election to be posted and published in accordance with law.


