

RESOLUTION NO. 47-2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING A BID TO DOWTECH SPECIALTY CONTRACTORS, INC FOR THE ELMDALE PUMP STATION RELOCATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Elmdale Pump Station is a key facility for providing an adequate supply of potable water to the far eastern portion of the City of Abilene (City); and

WHEREAS, during a comprehensive compliance inspection of the City's water supply system the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) listed inline booster station Elmdale Pump Station as an additional issue of concern due to the potential for low pressures to develop in the piping upstream of the pumps; and

WHEREAS, City staff and consulting engineers have been working with TCEQ staff to develop and implement remedies to address those concerns; and

WHEREAS, the City contracted with Jacob and Martin Engineering, LLC (JM) for the preparation of plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, project supervision, and project administration for the relocation of the Elmdale Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, Dowtech Specialty Contractors, Inc. (Dowtech) submitted the lowest qualifying bid totaling \$1,648,600.00 for the for the Elmdale Pump Station Relocation Project, and JM has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to Dowtech.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Dowtech Specialty Contractors, Inc. for the Elmdale Pump Station Relocation Project in the amount of \$1,648,600.00.
