

RESOLUTION NO. 60-2017

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO AMEND THE SPILLMAN  
PURCHASE AGREEMENT IN EXCESS OF \$50,000.**

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution 08-2016 the City Council approved a contract with Spillman Technologies for the purchase of public safety hardware and software technology; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City subsequently executed a Purchase and License Agreement (hereinafter, the "contract") with Spillman Technologies in the amount of \$1,384,992; and,

**WHEREAS**, this City Council finds certain modules previously purchased in the contract are not needed for operational purposes; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene may amend the original contract to eliminate the four modules that are not needed, and the amended contract cost would be reduced to \$1,242,131, for a total cost savings of \$142,861, to be applied as a credit for future Spillman billing, in addition to a decrease in the maintenance fee of \$21,537 during the second year.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ABILENE, TEXAS:**

PART 1: The City Manager is authorized to amend the contract with Spillman Technologies in order to eliminate the following modules and their associated costs, as listed below:

- A. Impound Module (\$12,791)
- B. Texas Crash Module (\$63,095)
- C. Response Plans Module (\$27,304)
- D. Spillman Touch Module (\$39,671)
