

RESOLUTION NO. 70-2017  
DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE  
COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

WHEREAS, this City Council deems it advisable to give notice of intention to issue certificates of obligation of the City of Abilene Texas, as hereinafter provided; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed, was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

1. Attached hereto is a form of the Notice of Intention to issue Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, the form and substance of which is hereby adopted and approved.

2. The City Secretary shall cause said notice to be published in substantially the form attached hereto, in a newspaper, as defined by Subchapter C, Chapter 2051, Texas Government Code, of general circulation in the area of said City, once a week for two consecutive weeks, the date of the first publication thereof to be at least 30 days prior to the date tentatively set for the adoption of the ordinance authorizing the issuance of such certificates of obligation as shown in said notice.

3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE  
COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE  
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, at its meeting to commence at 8:30 A.M. on June 22, 2017, at its regular meeting place in the City Hall, 555 Walnut Street, Abilene, Texas, tentatively proposes to adopt an ordinance authorizing the issuance of interest bearing certificates of obligation, in one or more series, in an amount not to exceed \$21,350,000 for paying all or a portion of the City's contractual obligations incurred in connection with: (i) acquiring, improving, renovating and equipping a building structure consisting of three units, one unit to be used for a law enforcement center for police, municipal courts and 911 communications center, one to be used for water utilities offices and one to be used for records storage, and related landscaping, parking and infrastructure for the facility; (ii) constructing, acquiring installing and equipping additions, extensions and improvements to the City's waterworks and sewer system; and (iii) legal, fiscal and engineering fees in connection with such projects. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such certificates of obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law and from a pledge of limited surplus revenues of the City's waterworks and sewer system, remaining after payment of all operation and maintenance expenses thereof, and all debt service, reserve, and other requirements in connection with all of the City's revenue bonds or other obligations (now or hereafter outstanding), which are payable from all or any part of the net revenues of the City's waterworks and sewer system. The certificates of obligation are to be issued, and this notice is given, under and pursuant to the provisions of Texas Local Government Code, Subchapter C of Chapter 271.
