

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A LOCAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT (LPAFA) WITH THE STATE OF TEXAS THROUGH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) is an active member of the Abilene Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Advisory Board has reviewed and approved certain Urban Area Corridor Project Improvements located within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements will increase safety and mobility for the general public; and

WHEREAS, the approved Urban Area Corridor Project includes financial participation from the MPO, the Texas Department of Transportation, and the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project improvements include the removal and relocation of the existing State Highway 36 exit on Northbound Loop 322 approximately 2000 feet south of the existing ramp, the East frontage road will become a one-way road from the new exit ramp to Highway 36, and paving improvements will be made to the East frontage road from the new exit ramp to Highway 36; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of this project is \$768,000.000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the LPAFA, and to commit a fixed amount of \$100,000.00 as the City of Abilene's financial participation in this local transportation project.
