

RESOLUTION NO. 106-2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR THE RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Abilene, Texas, to seek available funding for the purchase of Rifle-Resistant Body Armor that will assist the Abilene Police Department in protecting and serving the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, City Council of the City of Abilene assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council approves the submission of the grant application to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

PART 2: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents for said grant.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
