

RESOLUTION NO. 121-2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC HIBBS AND TODD INC. FOR THE WASTEWATER SYSTEM MASTER PLAN UPDATE 2017.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and a sanitary sewer collection system which is a part of the Publically Owned Treatment Works authorized by Texas Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit Number WQ0010334004; and

WHEREAS, much of the existing sewerage was installed many years ago, was designed for serving a much smaller Abilene, and is in need of repairs, expansions, and upgrades; and

WHEREAS, excessive inflows and infiltration (I&I) during heavy rainfall events results in surcharging of mains and excessive flows at the Buck Creek Pump Station and Hamby Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater generated from ongoing residential and commercial expansion to the south creates capacity issues at the northern end of the collection system; and

WHEREAS, an update to the 2010 wastewater collection system master plan is needed in order to develop a current and comprehensive plan at address capacity, aging infrastructure, and growth related issues within Abilene's wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, staff solicited for statements of qualifications from qualified engineering firms to perform the wastewater collection system evaluation, modeling, and master plan; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the responses City staff selected enprotec/Hibbs & Todd Inc. to negotiate a contract scope of work and compensation valued at \$318,000 for the Wastewater System Master Plan Update 2017; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract with enprotec/Hibbs & Todd Inc. in the amount of \$318,000.00 for the Wastewater System Master Plan Update 2017.


