

RESOLUTION NO. 138-2017

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT WITH MAXWELL  
ASPHALT FOR TAXIWAY SEAL COAT REHABILITATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, Abilene Regional Airport participates in the Airport Improvement Program through the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), as authorized by the Congress of the United States of America;

**WHEREAS**, Abilene Regional Airport has demonstrated to FAA the need for Fiscal Year 2017 grant funding to perform taxiway seal coat rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, the city conducted CB-1764 for such project; and

**WHEREAS**, the city received three bids and Maxwell Asphalt was the lowest responsible bidder; and


**WHEREAS**, the cost of this contract is \$698,434.85 and is included for funding in Airport Improvement Program Grant 47.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ABILENE, TEXAS:**

- I. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the contract with Maxwell Asphalt for Abilene Regional Airport's Taxiways Seal Coat Rehabilitation project.
- II. That Ninety Percent (90%), which is \$628,591.36, of this cost is funded by FAA AIP Grant 47 and Ten Percent (10%), which is \$69,843.49, is the city's Local Grant Match funded by the 2015 General Obligation Bond Proposition 9.
