

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-2018**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING A BID TO GENECO TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR THE O.H. IVIE INTAKE PUMP STATION HVAC IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Ivie Pipeline System that includes the O.H. Ivie Intake Pump Station (Intake PS); and

**WHEREAS**, the Intake PS consists of three raw water intake pumps for which two of those are controlled utilizing variable frequency drive (VFD) units to allow operators to select flow quantities by remotely manipulating the speed of the pump motor; and

**WHEREAS**, the VFD units consist of cabinets containing electronic programmable controllers and banks of capacitors which generate large amounts of heat while in operation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City contracted with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) to evaluate the originally installed Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) equipment installed at the Intake PS, and the Engineer determined that the existing system is overloaded and worn out and recommends that it be replaced with redesigned and upgraded equipment for improved reliability and performance; and

**WHEREAS**, Geneco Technologies, Inc. (Geneco) submitted the lowest qualifying bid totaling \$214,883.00 for the O.H. Ivie Intake Pump Station HVAC Improvements Project, and EHT has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to Geneco; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Geneco Technologies, Inc. for the O.H. Ivie Intake Pump Station HVAC Improvements Project in the amount of \$214,883.00.
