

RESOLUTION NO. 23-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING A BID TO THE RYAN COMPANY FOR THE O.H. IVIE ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the O.H. Ivie Pipeline System which includes about 20 miles of high voltage electrical transmission lines and two electrical substations located at each of the Intake Pump Station and the Booster Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, the primary switches require manual operation made from close proximity to the switches, and the substations are not equipped with sufficient monitoring or automated control capabilities or a backup battery supply in order to adequately protect the equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City contracted with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) for the evaluation of the substations and the preparation of plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, project supervision (not RPR), and project administration for the O.H. Ivie Electrical Substation Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project provides for an automated primary side circuit switcher, DC battery backup for relaying and SCADA equipment, power factor correction, and other equipment, control, and security improvements; and

WHEREAS, The Ryan Company (Ryan) submitted the lowest qualifying bid totaling \$1,249,667.00 for the O.H. Ivie Electrical Substation Improvements Project, and EHT has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to Ryan; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with The Ryan Company for the O.H. Ivie Electrical Substation Improvements Project in the amount of \$1,249,667.00.
